

RECYCLING SERVICE CONTINUED

Cart Placement

All recycling carts should be at the curb with the handles facing the house. Carts must be at least two feet away from trash, other containers and any fixed objects.

Special Recycling Information

The following items must be recycled but are not included with your every other week recycling collection. To arrange for a curbside pick-up of the items listed below (fee charged), contact Waste Management Customer Service (888) 960-0008. **NOTE: You may also take these items to the Public Works drop-off site.**

- Metals (including items 50% or more metal)
- Lawn mowers
- Large appliances: air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators/freezers, microwaves, stoves, washers/dryers, water heaters/softeners
- Bicycles
- Tires (max 4, off rims)

The Public Works drop-off facility is located at 410 Investment Ct in Verona. (608) 845-6695. More information on materials that Public Works accepts is included elsewhere in this brochure.

BULK WASTE SERVICE

Bulk waste will continue to be collected curbside. See the lists below to determine acceptable bulk waste items.

Bulk Waste accepted curbside

- Small appliance not banned from landfills (i.e. toasters)
- Furniture
- Small auto parts in containers, other than batteries
- Box springs and mattresses
- Carpet and pads (no wider than 3 feet, rolled up, not weighing more than 50 lbs.)
- Remodeling materials: maximum of five 30 gal garbage cans not exceeding 50 lbs. each. Wood and drywall must be cut in three foot lengths and piled neatly. *NOTE: Any remodeling materials over this amount, you must contact Waste Management's Customer Service at (888) 960-0008 to arrange for a dumpster or Bagster Program.*
- Toilets and sinks

Unacceptable Bulk Waste

- Large appliances and white goods
- Metals (including items 50% or more metal)
- Lawn Mowers
- Bicycles
- Material in containers or bundles exceeding limits
- Large auto parts (engine blocks, fenders, tires, etc.)
- Stone, concrete, rubble, earth or sod
- Tree trunks or stumps
- Branches, tree trimmings, leaves, grass clippings
- Tires

Move-outs

Residents are allow to place their 96- gallon cart and 5 30- gallon containers or 5 garbage bags of refuse and 3 furniture items curbside when moving. In the event that you exceed this amount, the refuse will be collected and you will be invoiced for this service based on the quantity of extra refuse collected. Minimum billing will be \$125.00. Hazardous Items

Waste Management will not collect solid or liquid hazardous waste. Examples include paint, pesticides and petroleum derivatives, such as motor oil and solvents, and explosive items.

Missed Collection

Despite our best efforts, we occasionally miss scheduled collections. If we do, please call us at 608-845-6695 as soon as you can. We will try to return on the same day to pick up without charge. If our driver has already left the City of Verona, we will pick up the missed stop the following day.

ACCEPTED ITEMS FOR RECYCLING AT PUBLIC WORKS DROP-OFF SITE (NO FEE except for tires)

- Metals (items 50 %or more metal)
- Waste oil/oil filters
- All appliances: AC units, stoves, refrigerators, microwaves, washers, dryers, water heaters etc.
- Landscape brick/block Landscape timbers
- Lawn mowers
- Yard waste (un-bagged)
- Bicycles
- Brush (put in yard waste bin)
- Tires (maximum of four, must be off rim) \$2/tire

BRUSH COLLECTION – Verona Public Works

Brush will be picked up curbside on the 2nd and 4th weeks of the month. For safety reasons, noncompliance of the guidelines described below will jeopardize collection of your brush.

- Collection is for tree trimmings, stumps and shrubs
- Brush cut/trimmed by persons/firms hired by the property owner will not be collected.
- Brush must be neatly stacked and parallel to the street. As you face the street, cut ends to your right.
- In the event of a major storm, brush should be placed curbside and will be picked up as soon as possible.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP

Pickup will be during the month of January. You must remove the bag or your tree will not be collected.

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

This collection will begin in October and run through mid-November. Leaves, lawn clippings and garden debris should be placed into the curb and will be picked weekly. Absolutely no bags!

Refuse and Recycling Collection Guide

New Waste Cart Service Starts February 22, 2016

Dear Verona Residents:

After a successful implementation of recycling carts in 2012, the City has decided to switch to carts for refuse service. Each resident will receive a green 96-gallon cart with a green lid for refuse which will be delivered in mid-February. Refuse will continue to be collected weekly on either Monday or Tuesday – please refer to the Refuse and Recycling Map and Schedule in this brochure – and recycling will be collected every other week. **Both waste and recycling containers must be placed curbside by 7:00 am** (but not more than 24 hours in advance), and must be removed no later than 24 hours after collection. Waste Management will collect trash and recycling between 7am and 6pm on your designated service day. Please note Bulk Item Collection will remain the same – see the guidelines for Bulk Waste Accepted Curbside elsewhere in this brochure. Waste Management and the City of Verona look forward to help keeping our community as clean – and green – as possible throughout 2016 and beyond.

REFUSE SERVICE

You can begin using your new green 96-gallon cart with the green lid as soon as it's delivered. Please use this cart for refuse only. The weight limit for the cart is 200 pounds. After a 30 day trial period, 64-gallon carts will be available upon request to replace the 96-gallon cart by calling the Public Works Department at 608-845-6695. Only use the green cart with the green lid for trash that cannot be recycled.

Cart Placement

Carts need to be at least 2 feet away from each other and any fixed object. All carts should be at the curb with the handles facing the house.

Additional Cart Rental

In the event that one 96-gallon cart is not sufficient for your weekly refuse needs, you can rent a second cart. For more information, please contact the Public Works Department at (608) 845-6695.


Disposal of Existing Refuse Containers

Should you want to dispose of your old refuse container, please place it inside or on top of your new 96-gallon refuse cart for collection. Your existing container is not recyclable because of the contamination inside of it.

RECYCLING SERVICE

Recycling will continue to be picked up every other week – see the Refuse and Recycling Map and Schedule on the next panel to determine if your recycling will be collected on Green or Gold weeks. Please use the green cart with the yellow lid for recyclables only. Place all recycled items in your recycling cart. The weight limit for the cart is 200 lbs.
